I come running, running back.



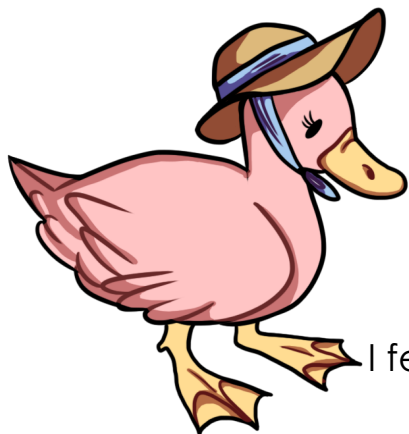
I am sad when I play
