#### Counting Forward

#### when you only have minutes!

This activity was created for when your children only have a few spare minutes as a supplement to other learning activities.

#### **HOW TO PREPARE**

- 1. Print and laminate each page, enlarging them if you'd like!
- Use a pencil tip to hold a paper clip in position on the center dot.
   Teach your children how to hold the pencil and flick the paper clip so it spins.

#### **HOW TO PLAY**

- 1. Spin the spinner using a pencil and paper clip.
- 2. Say the number the clip is pointing to.
- 3. Say the following three numbers.

For eg, if '23' is spun the child should say '23' and then count on the following 3 numbers "24, 25, 26." As the numbers are all written this is a great activity for children still gaining confidence, although they'll have to think hard when needing to go up into the next group of tens.


The numbers at the top are provided as a clear reference to numbers getting bigger as they move across the line.
